1. On camera

6. Sharing

7. The comments

Start with: reply to five comments on our page this week, warmly, as yourself.

8. Answering

When someone asks for prayer or opens up, a real person has to be there. This is the job that turns a viewer into a friend, and it is the one most often left empty.

Start with: read When It Gets Real, then put your hand up.

9. Praying

Over every post, before it goes out and after. Not a consolation role. If you think this project runs on the algorithm you have misread what it is.

Start with: pray over this week's posts by name.
